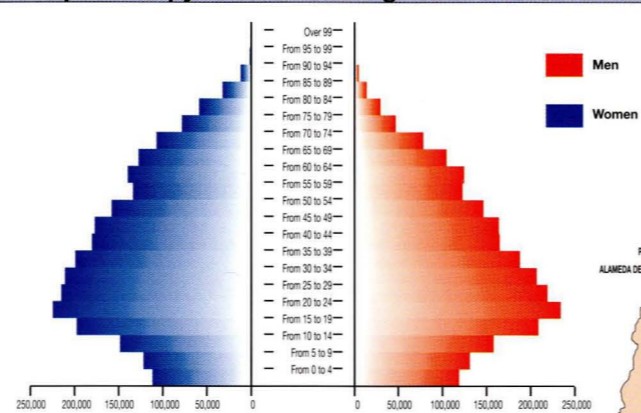

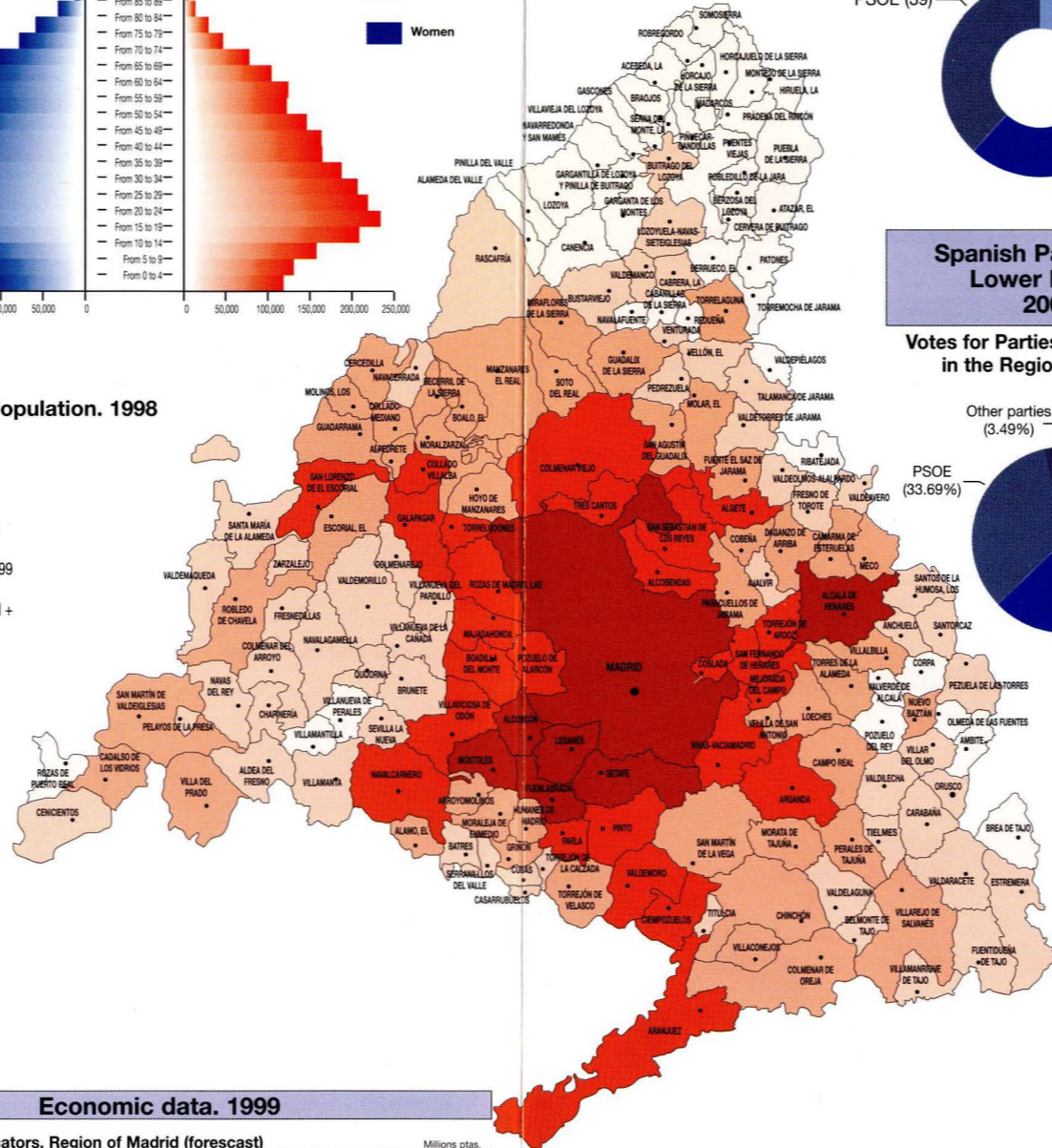

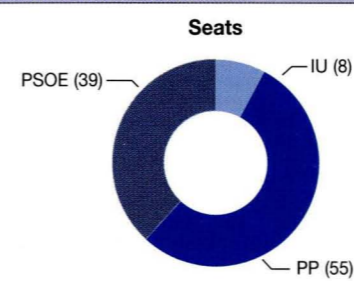
### Population pyramid of the Region of Madrid. 1996



### De Jure Population. 1998

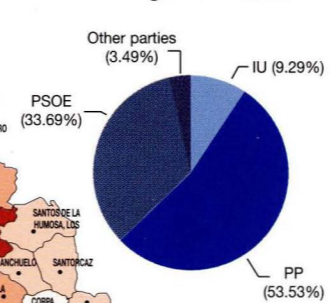


### Madrid Regional Parliament. 1999

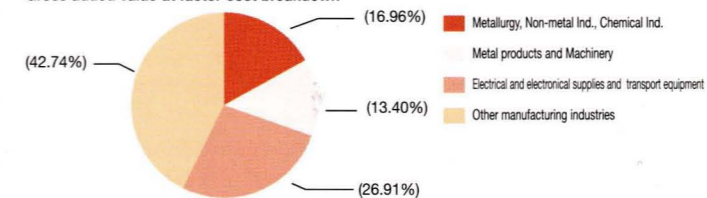
