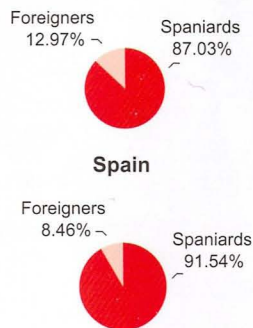


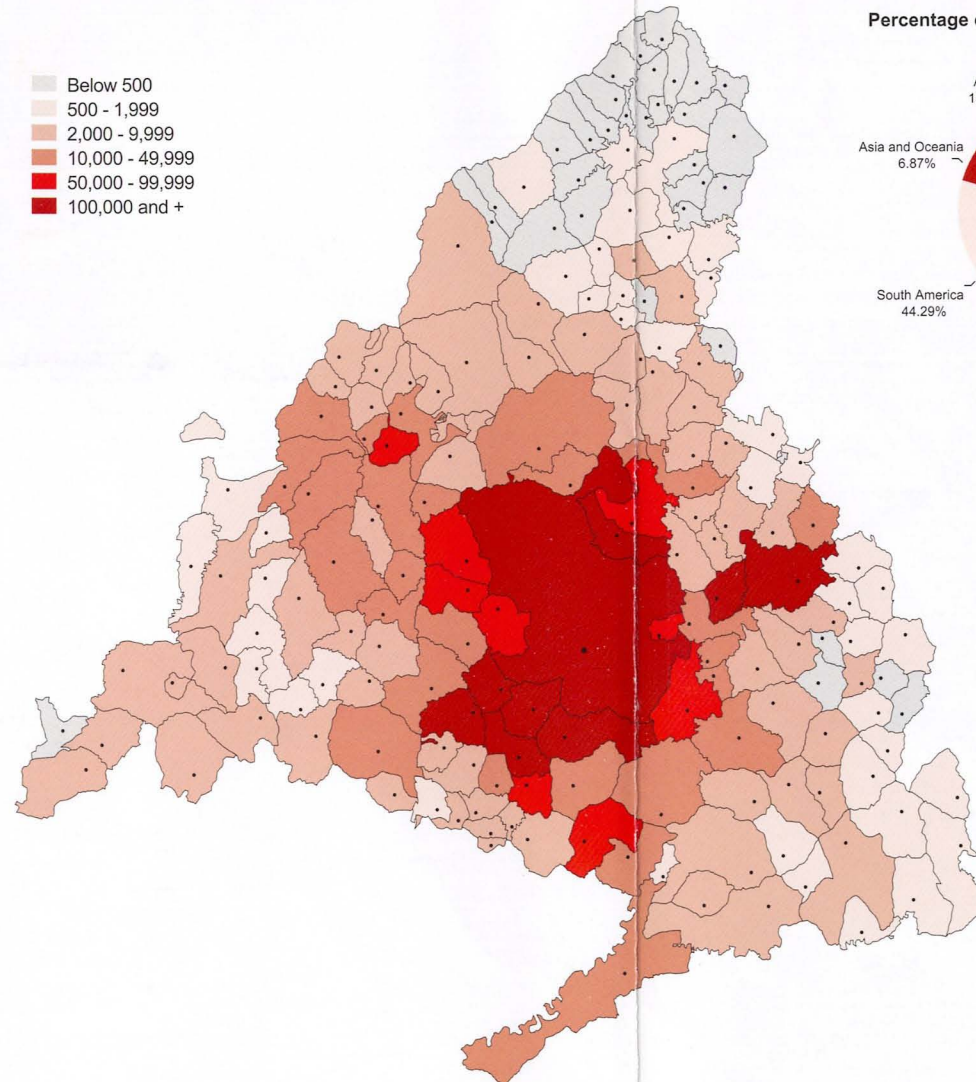

Region of Madrid

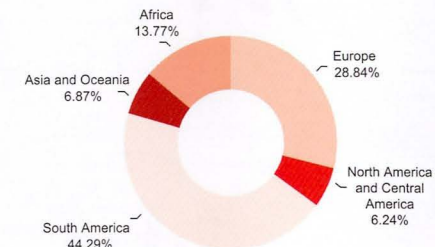


Official population (with registered residence). 2007

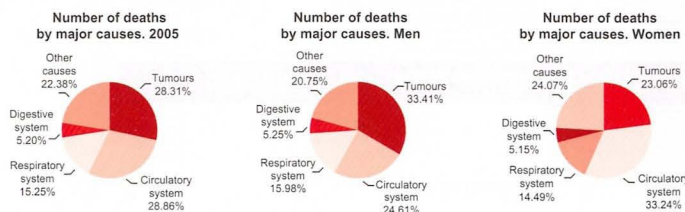

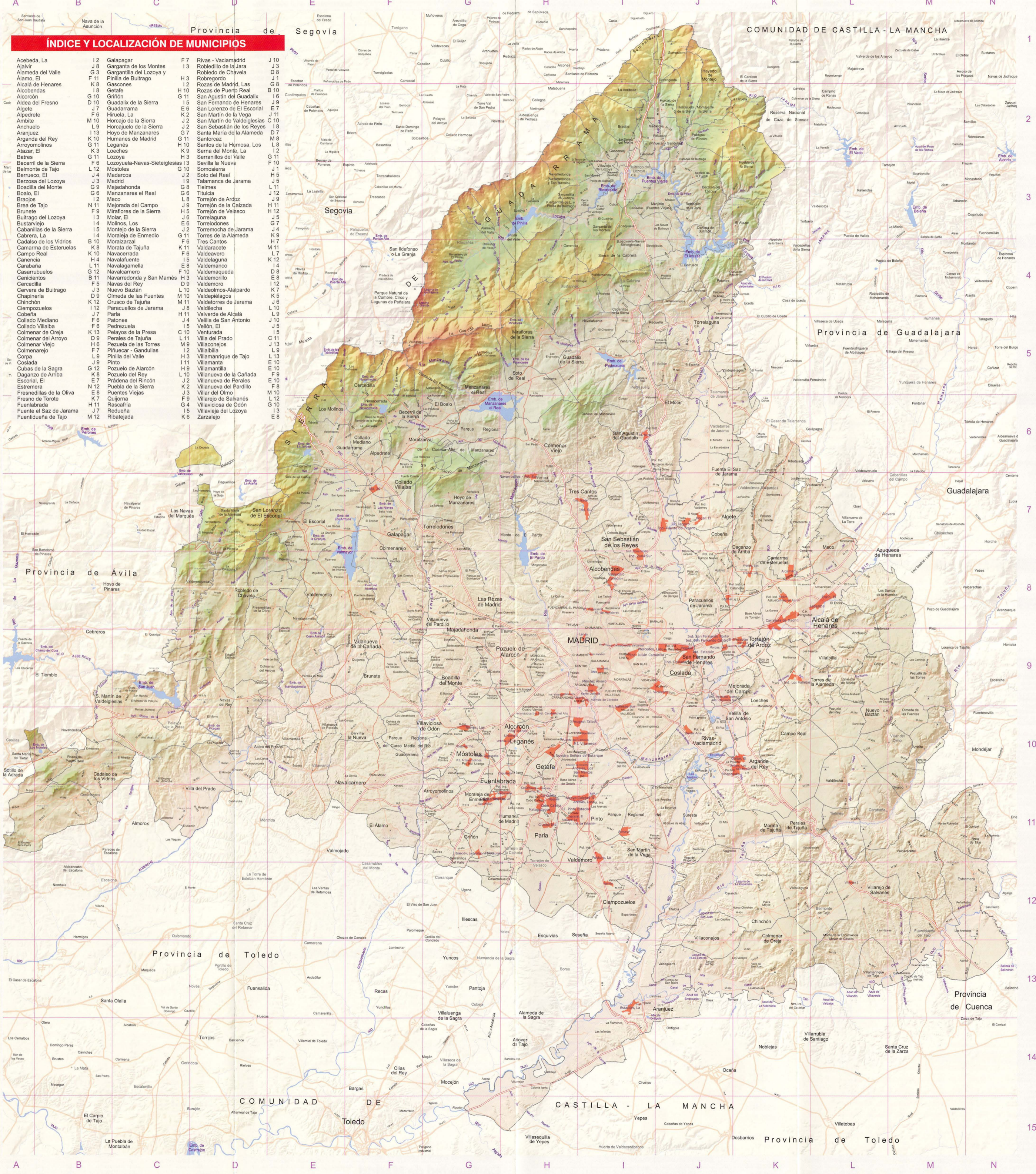
