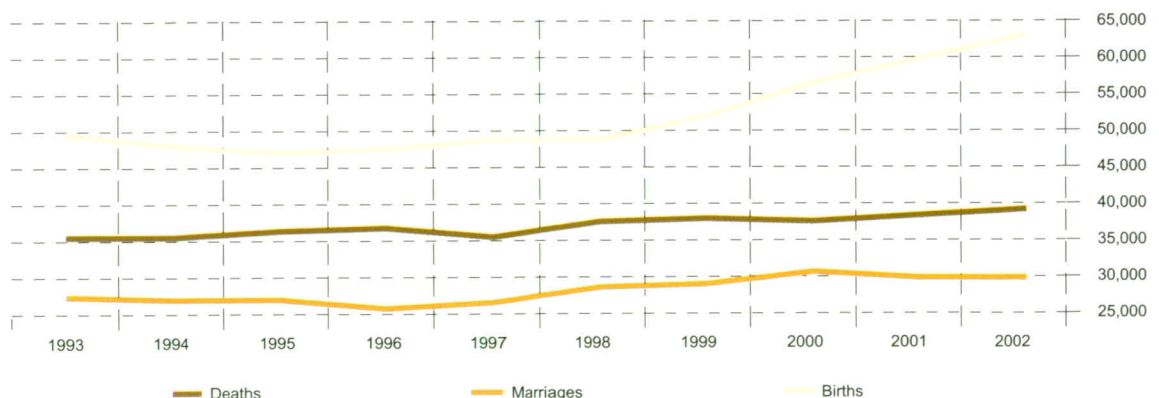

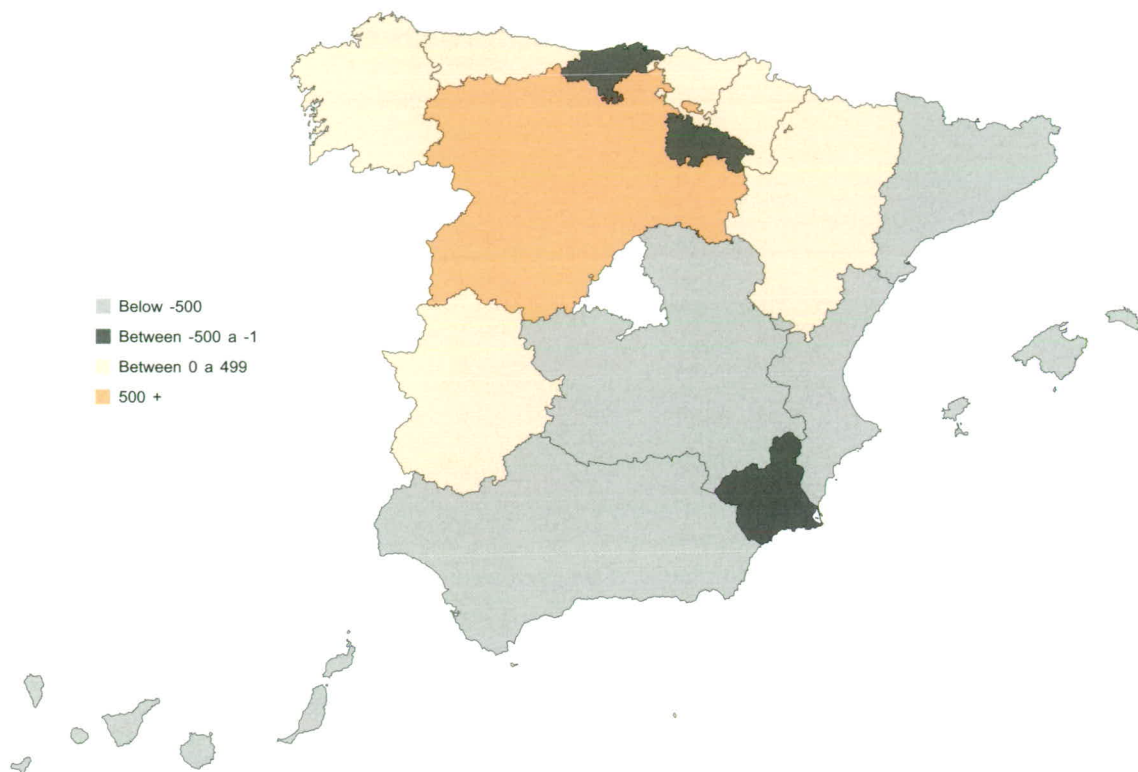

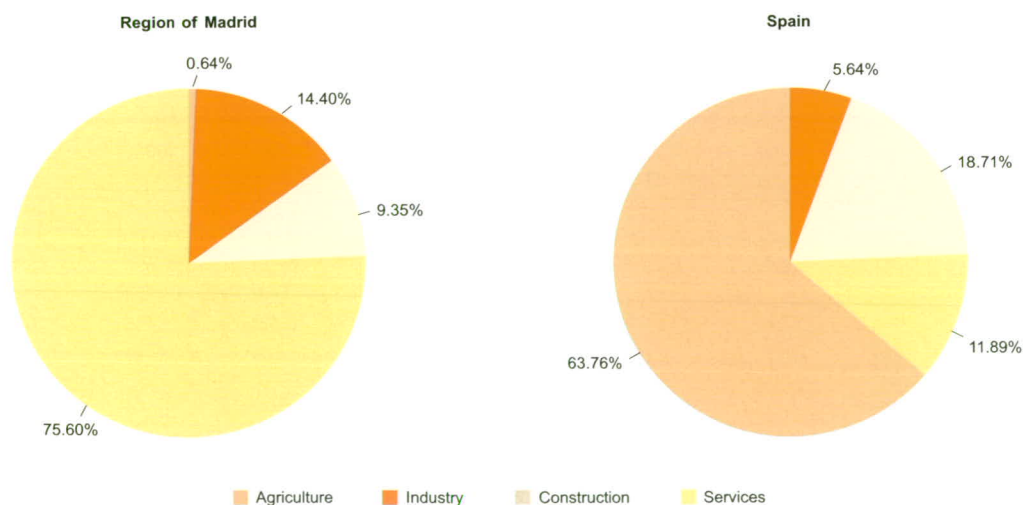

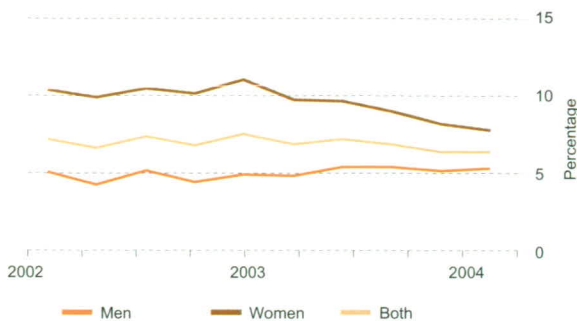

3.2. Breakdown of employment by sectors. 2003

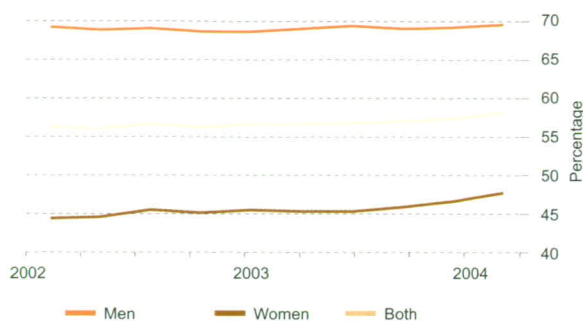


3.3. EPA*: year-to-year change in unemployment rate by sex

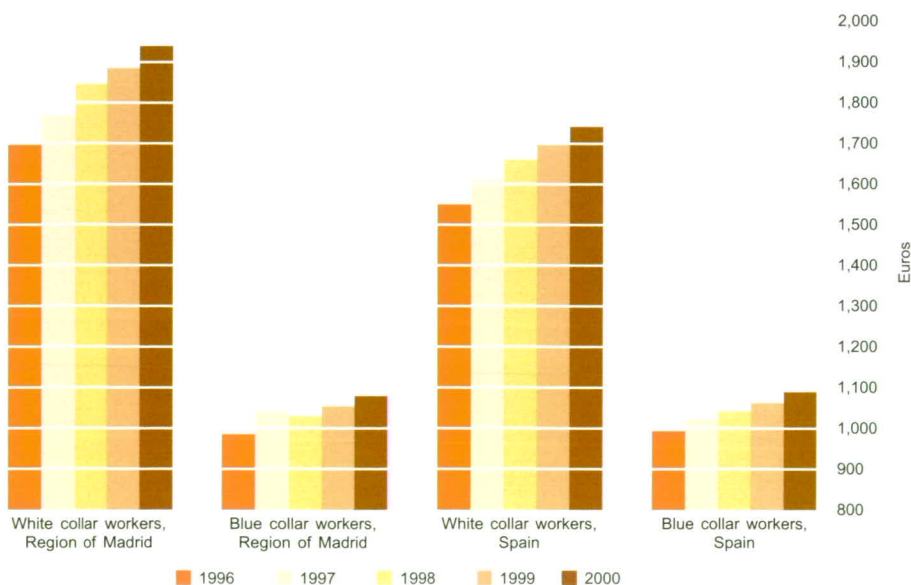

4.2. Monthly salaries of workers



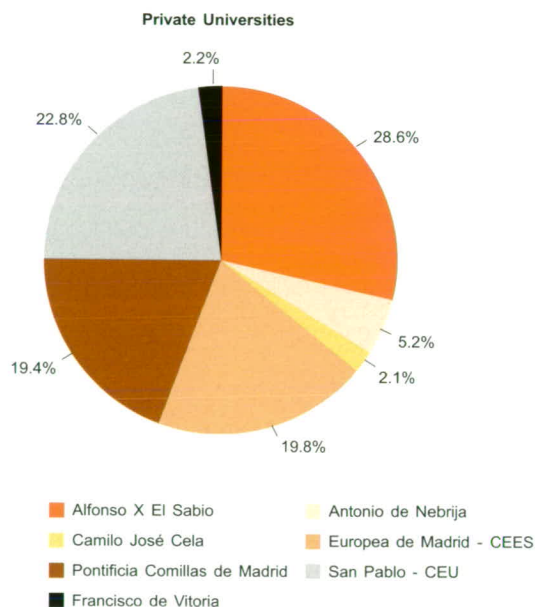
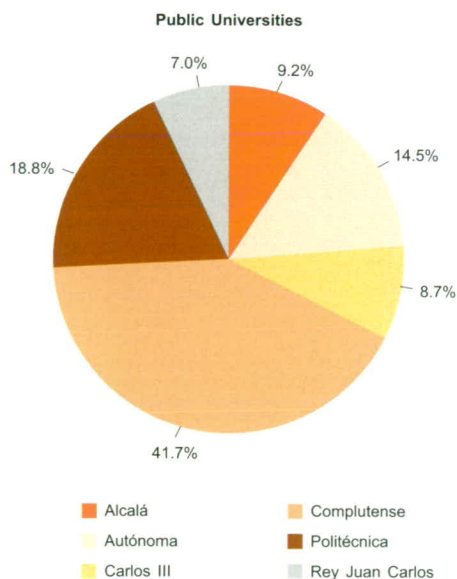

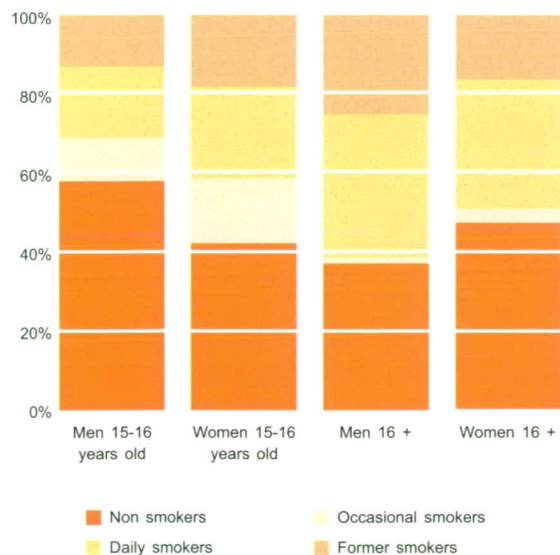

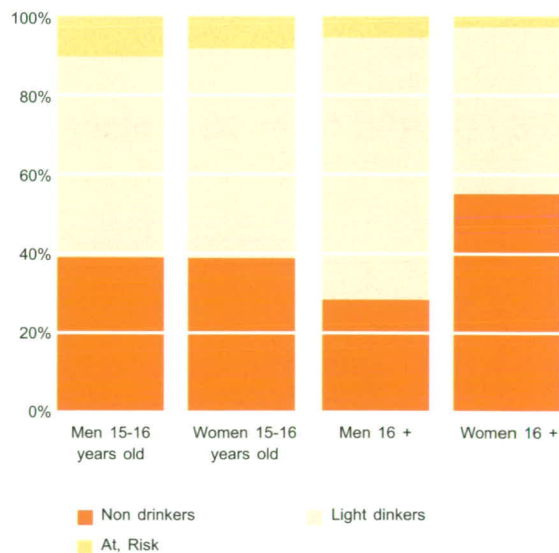

6.5. Breakdown of adult and teenage population by alcohol consumption. 2003



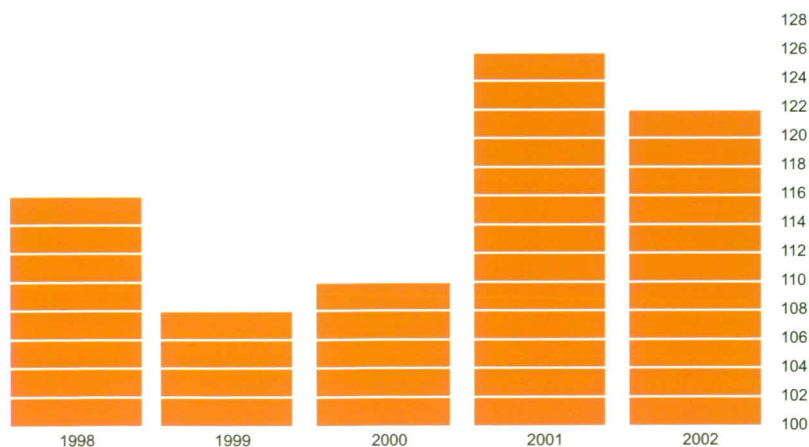

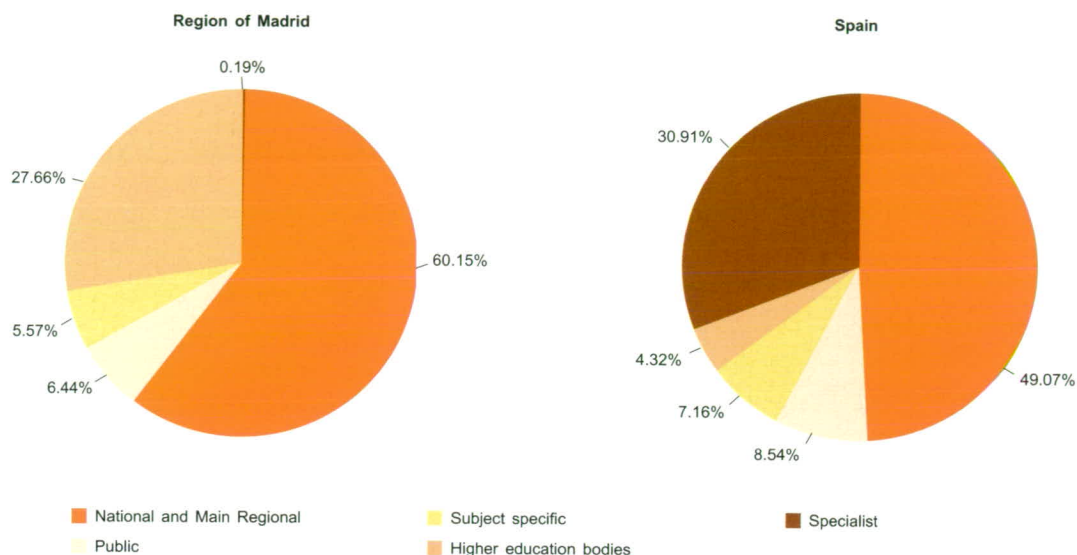

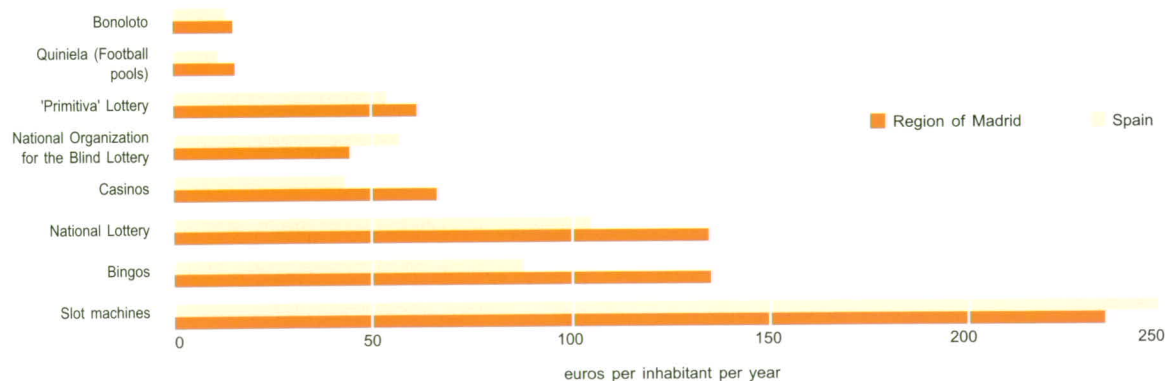

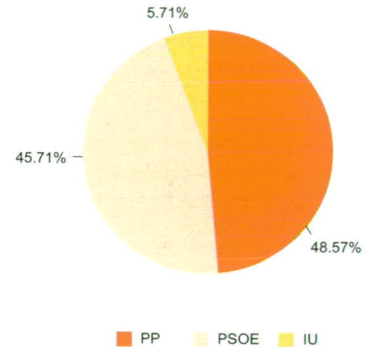

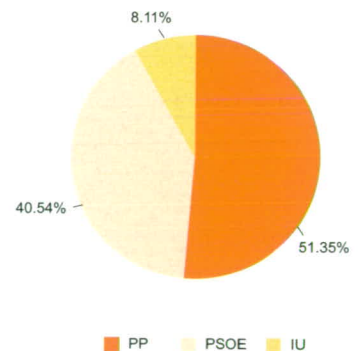
Breakdown of the seats.

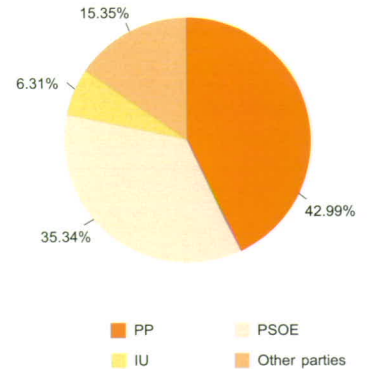

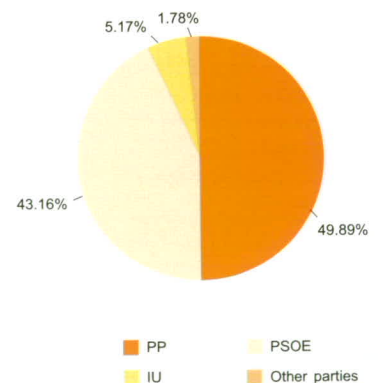
Breakdown of the councillors.

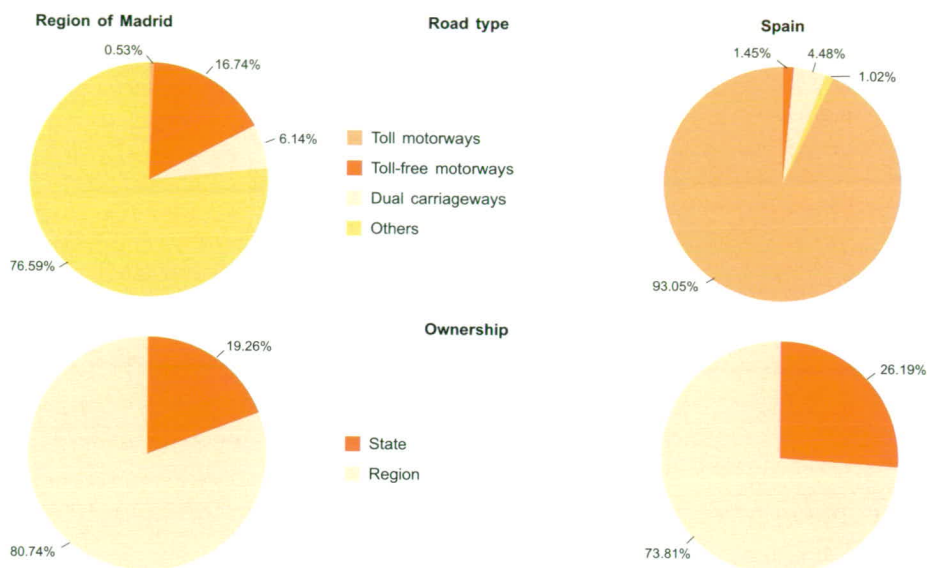

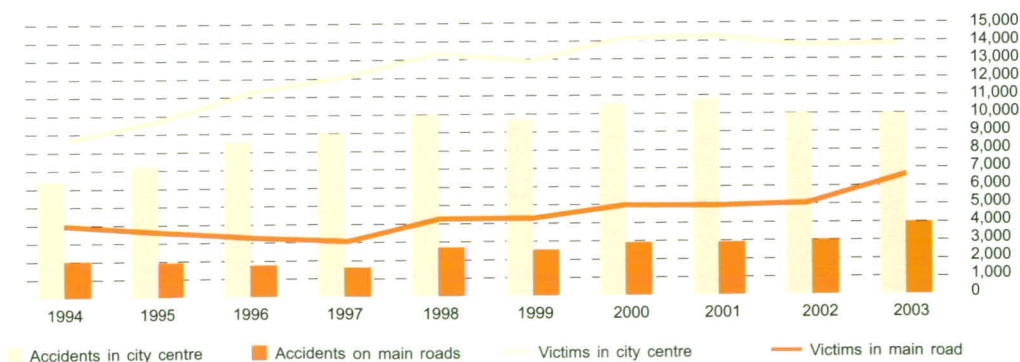

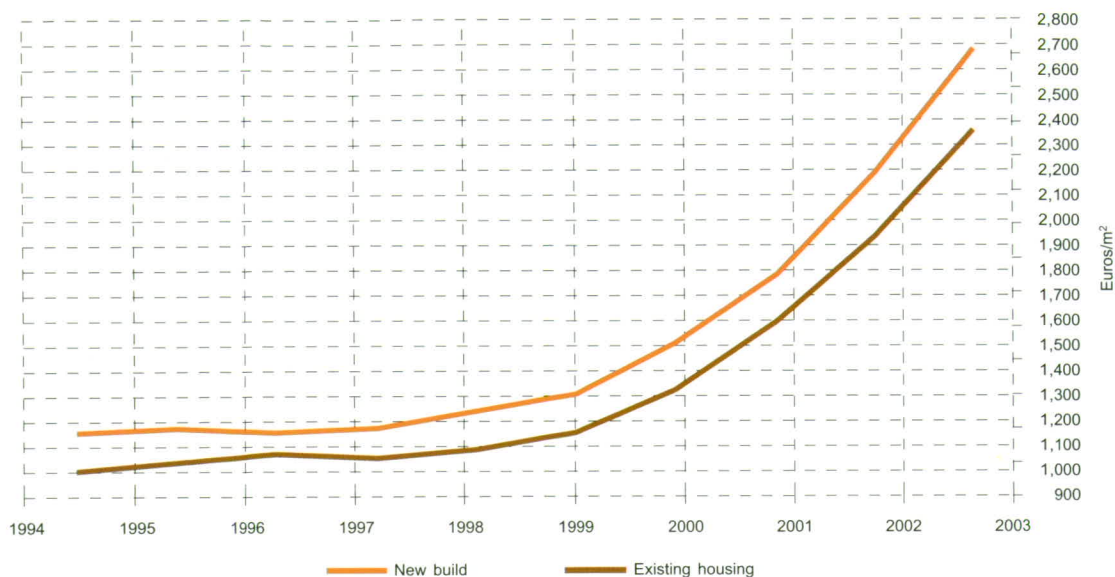

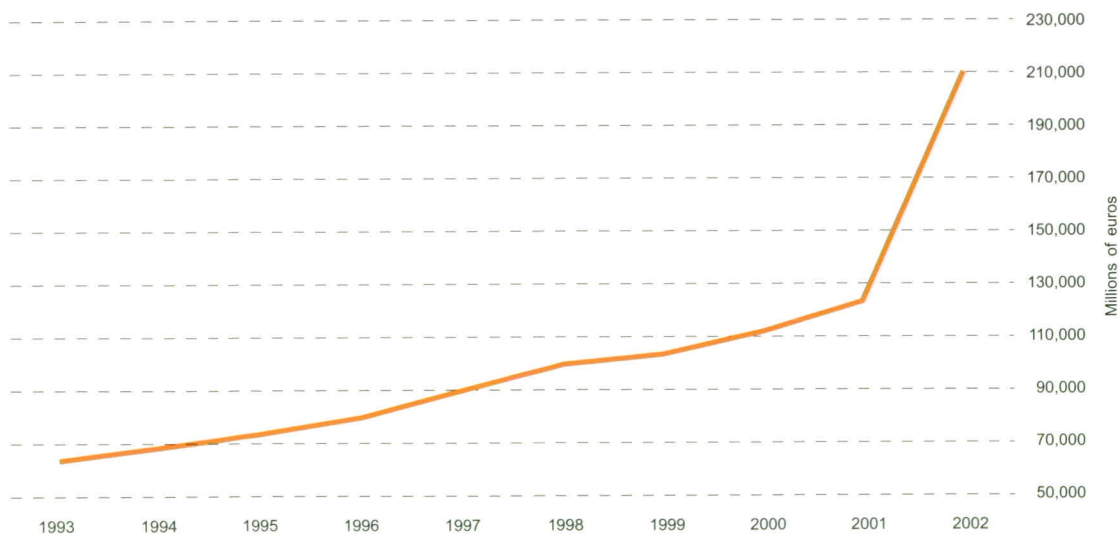
10.3. Price per m² of new build and existing housing

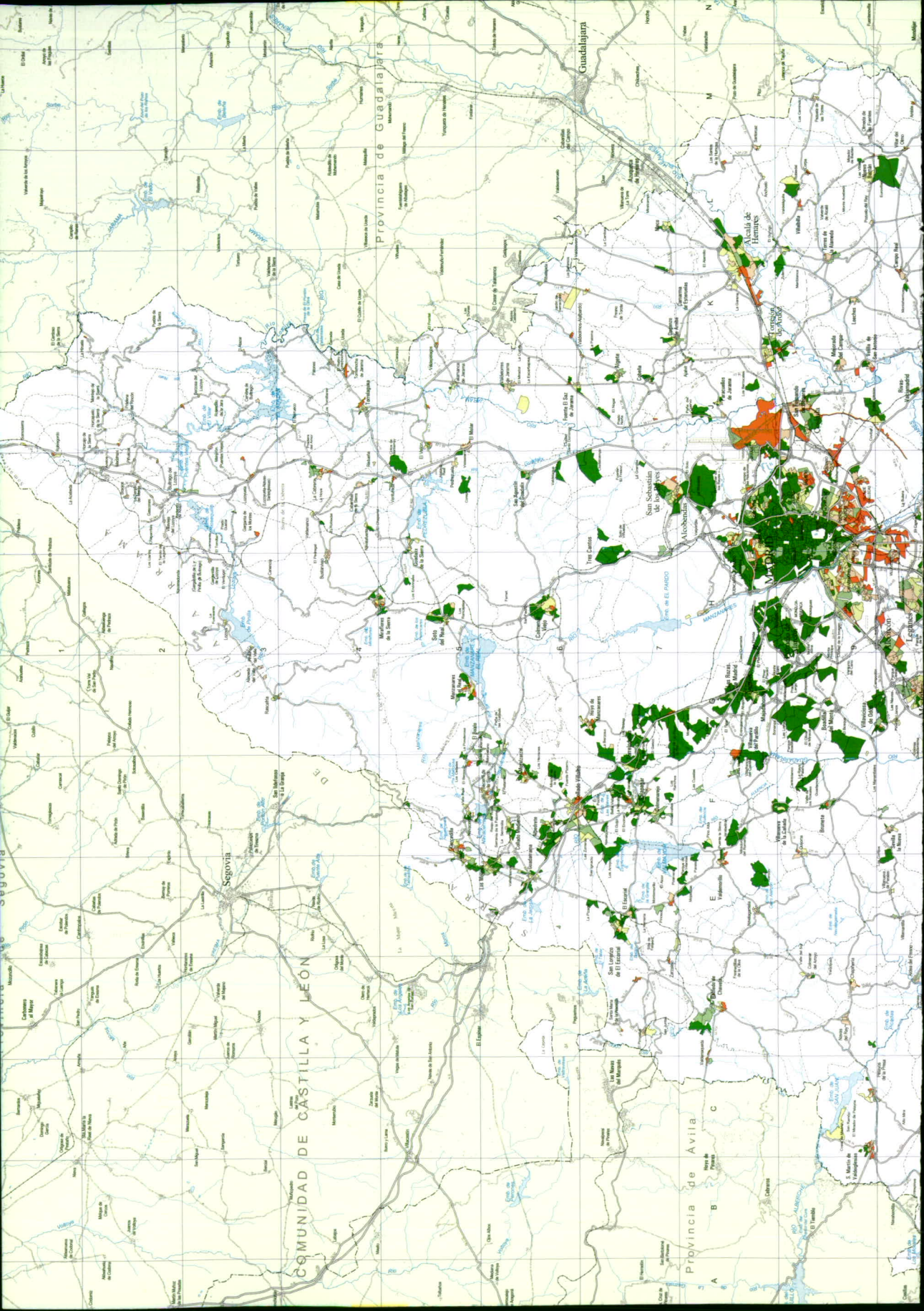

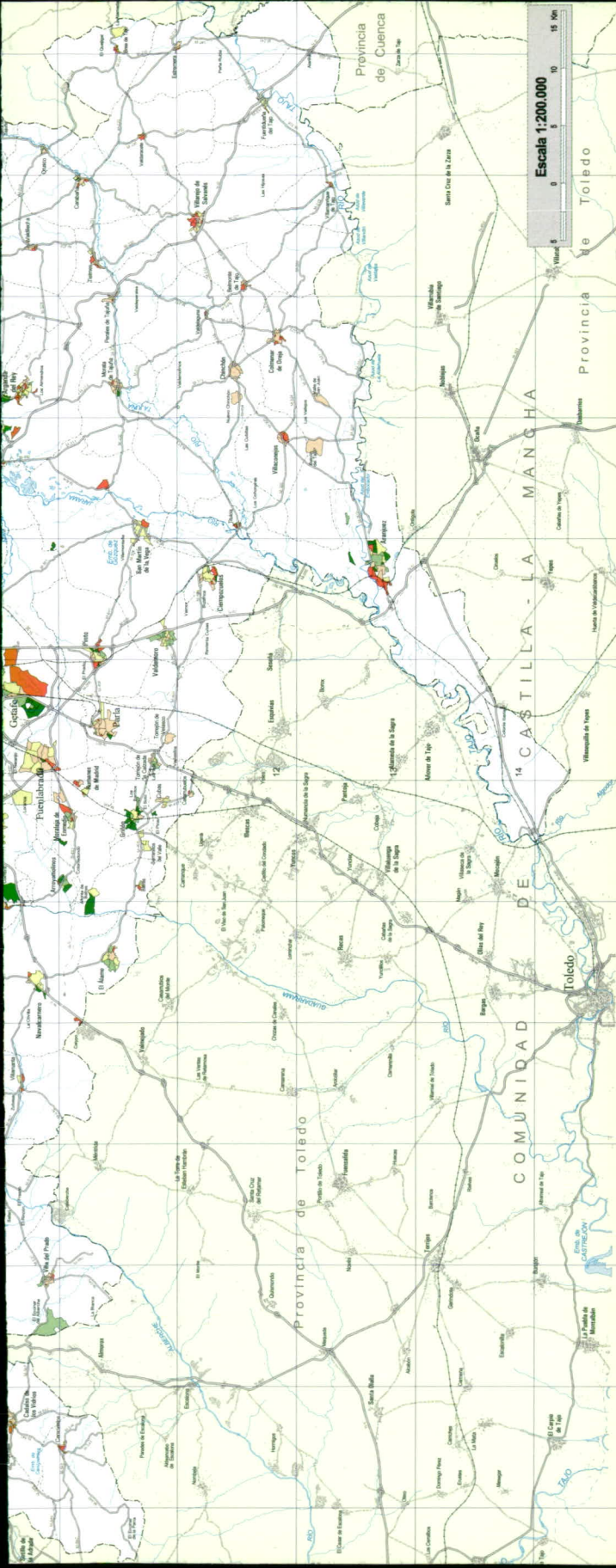

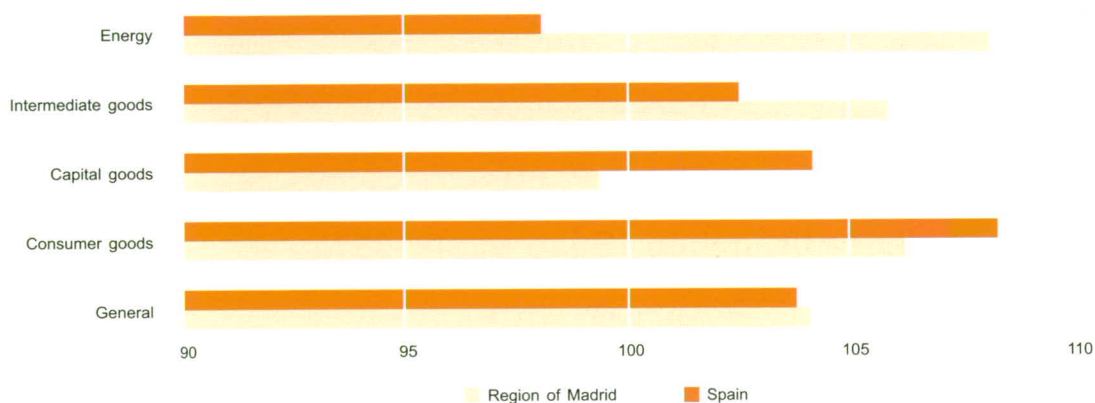

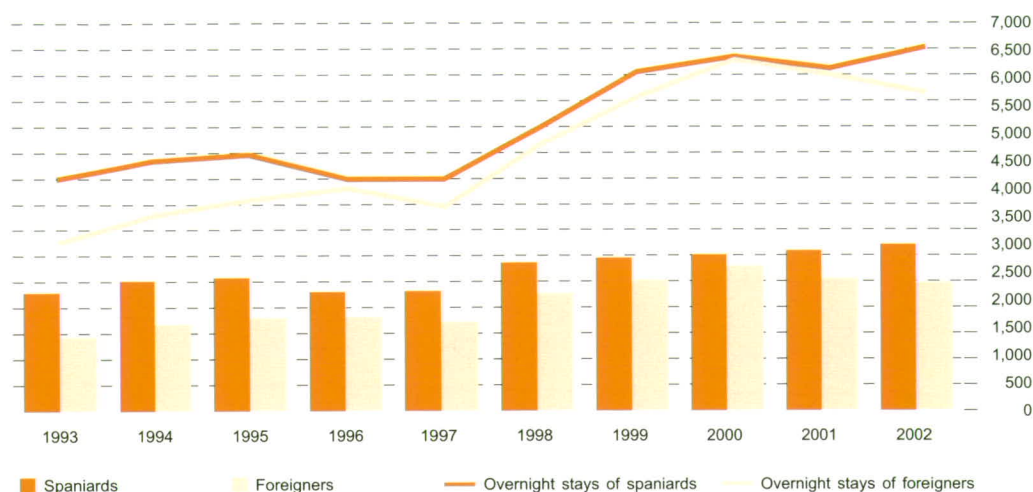

13.4. Visitors to the Region of Madrid and overnight stays in tourist accommodation

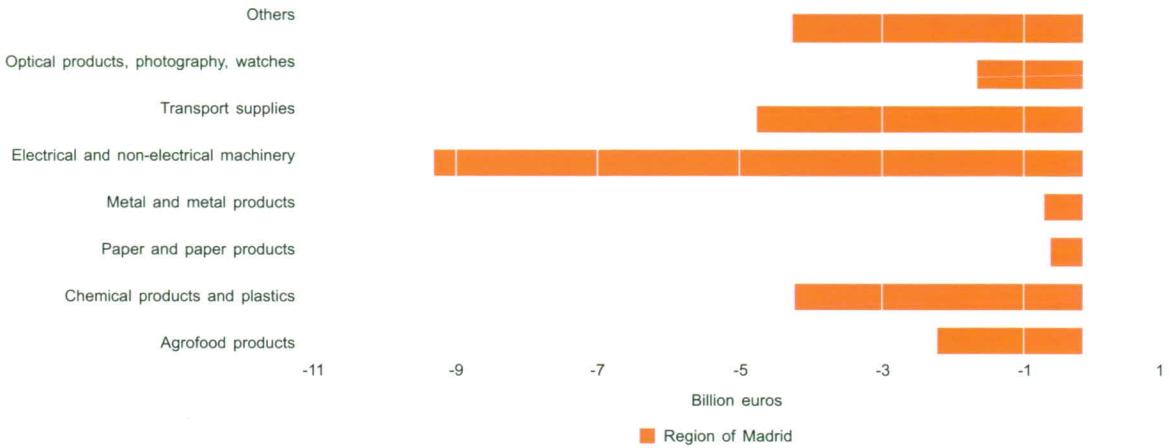

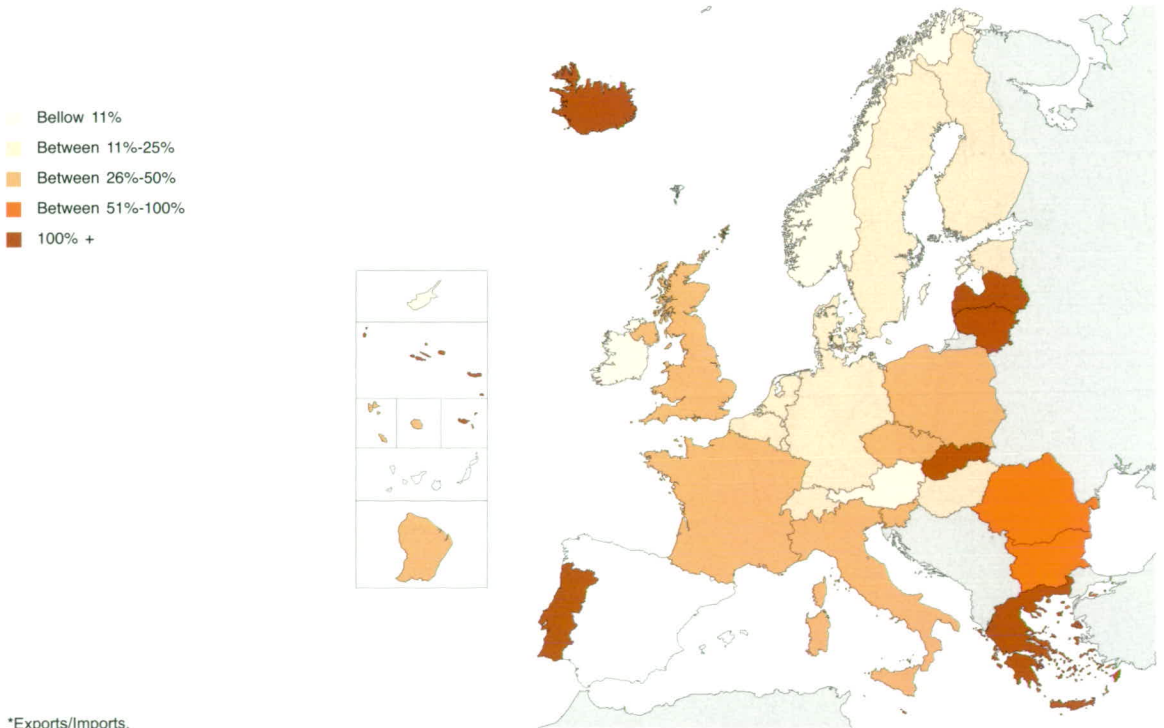

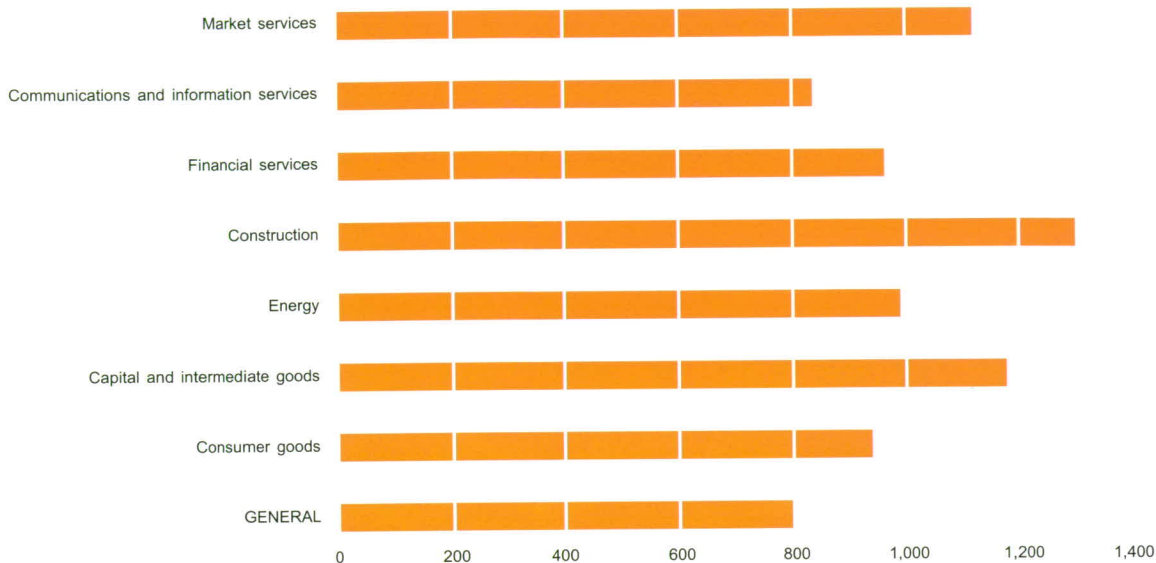

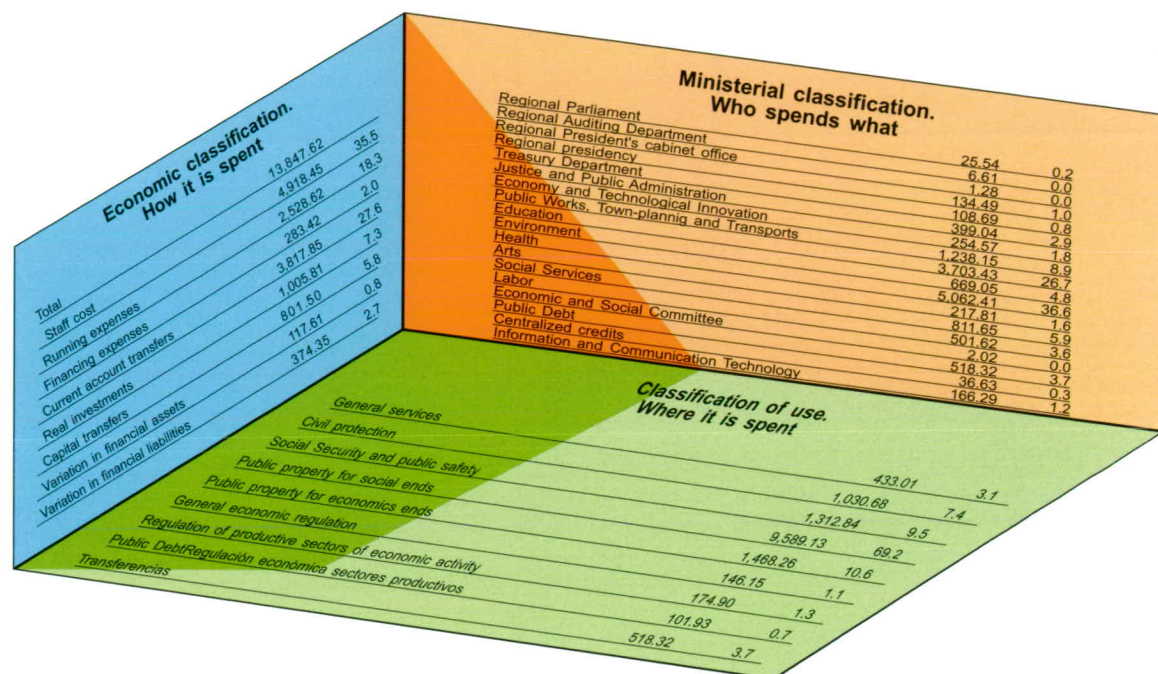

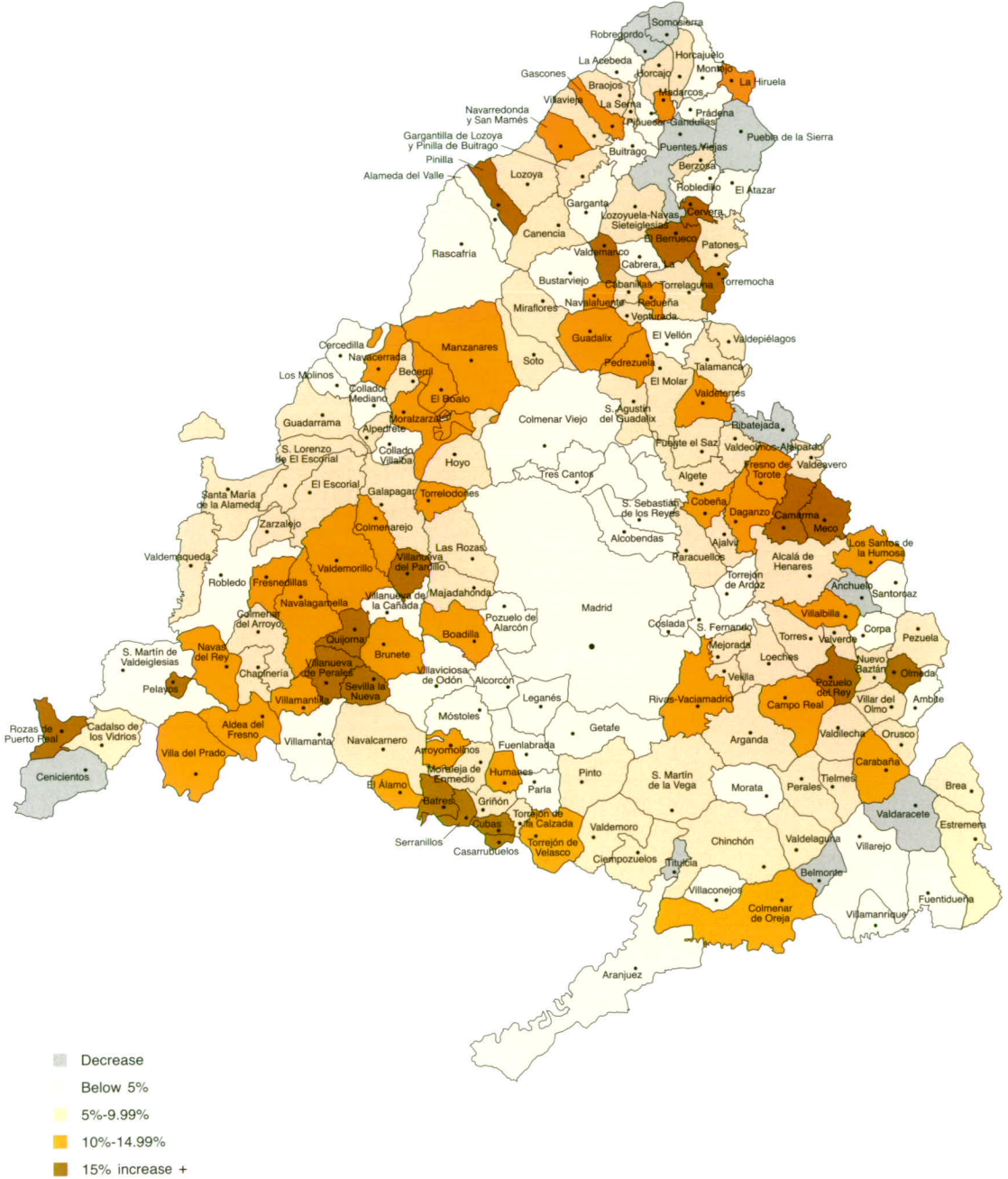

17.1. Population change (%). 2002-2003

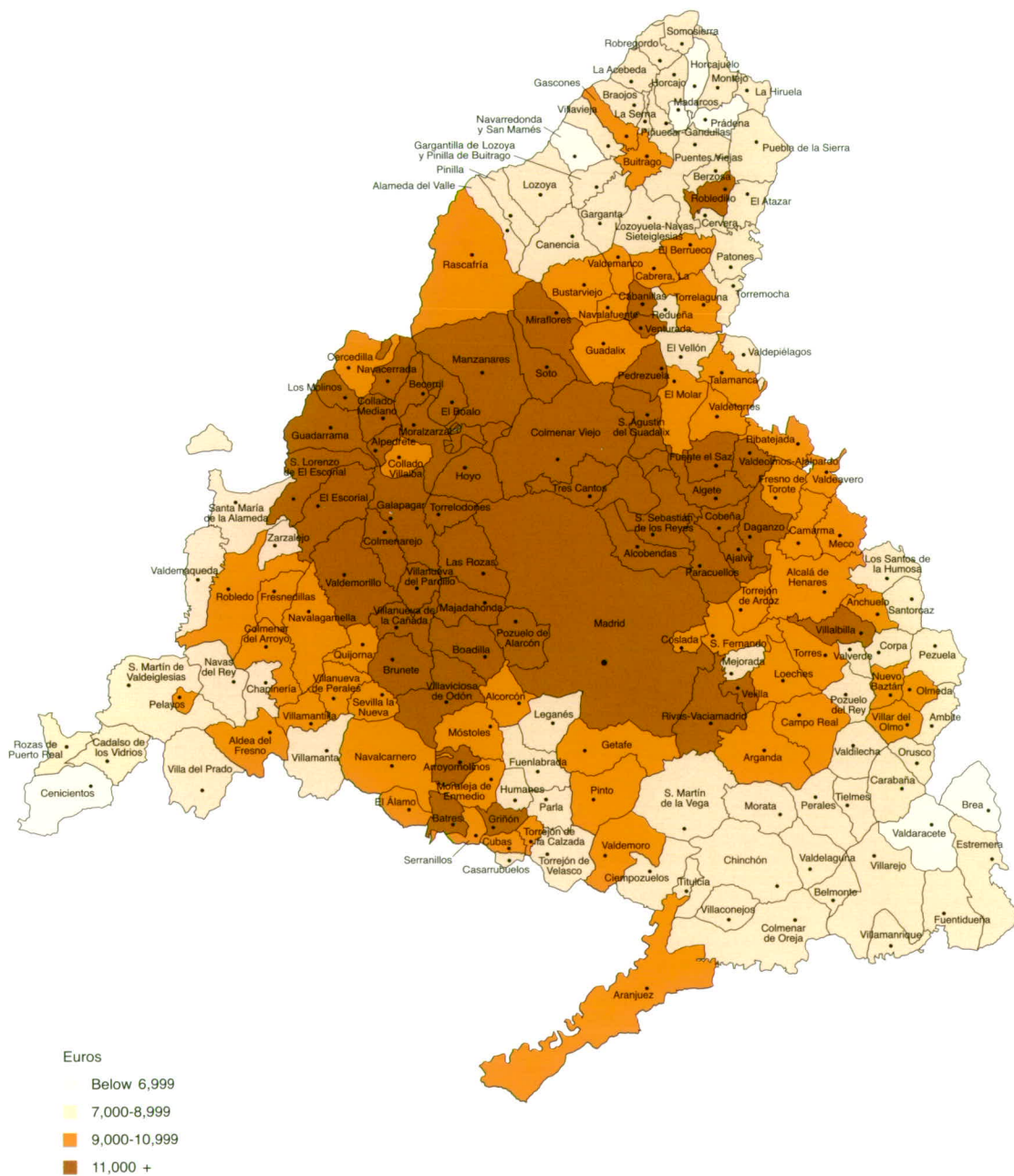


17.2. Population density. 2002

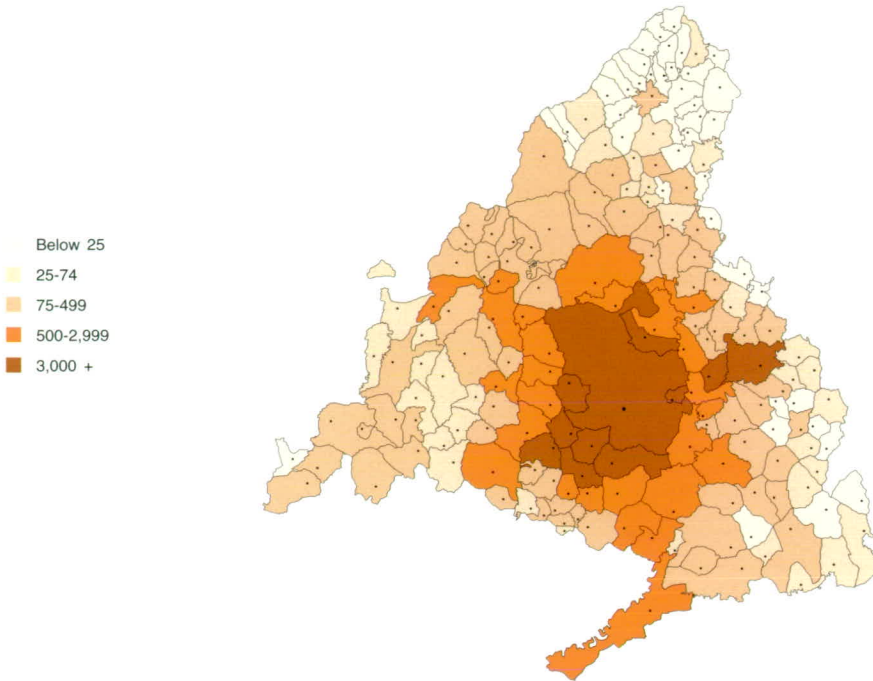

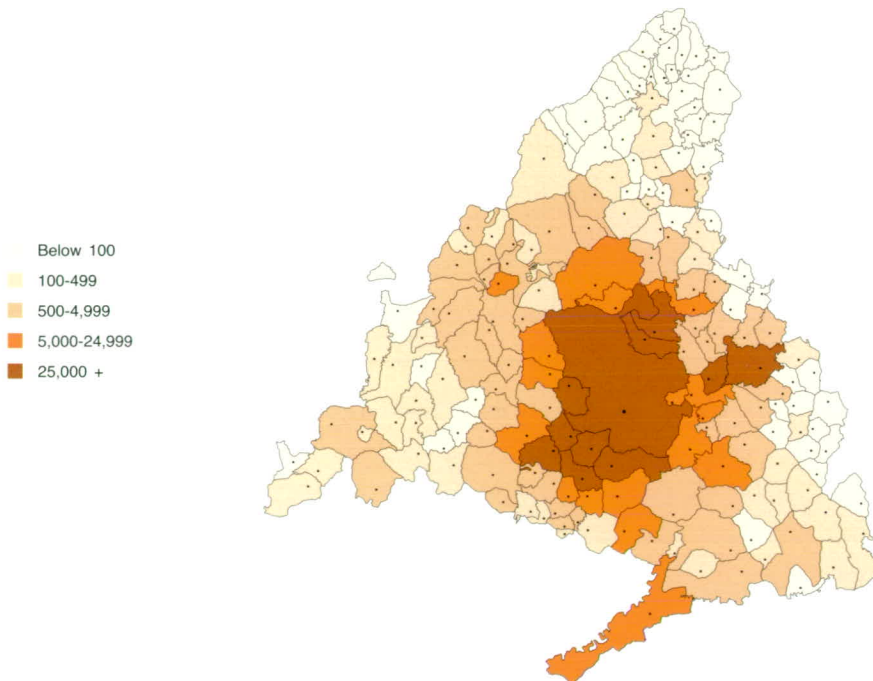
17.3. Gross disposable income per capita, broken down by municipality. 2001 (a)



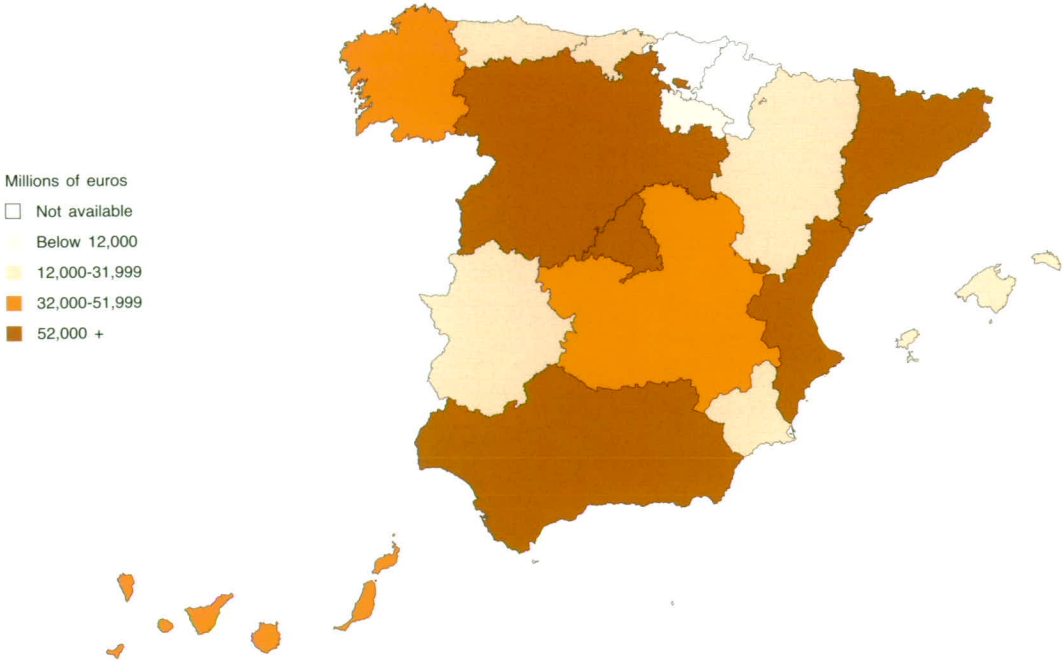
17.4. Business establishments. 2003

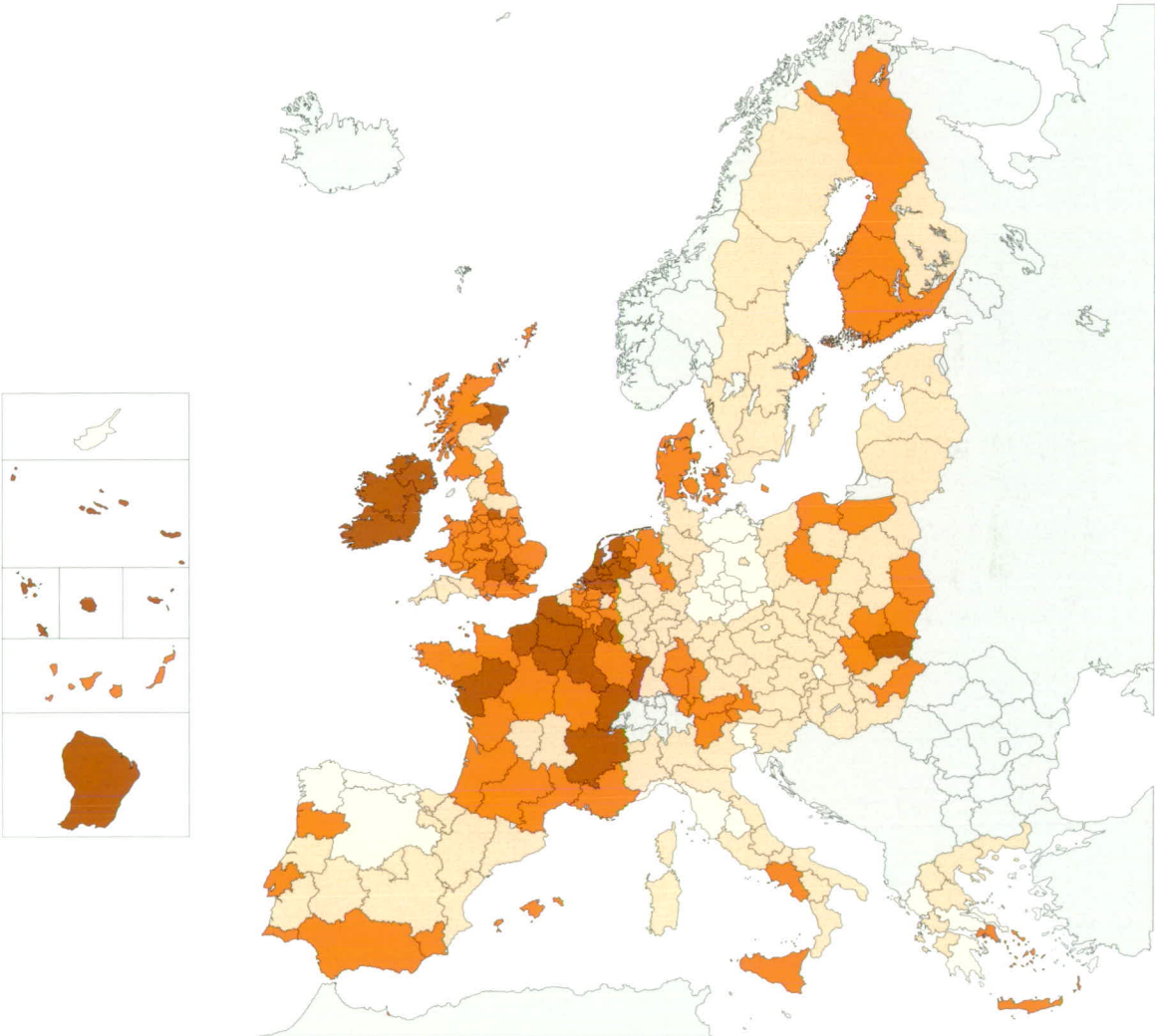


17.7. Unemployment rate. 2003



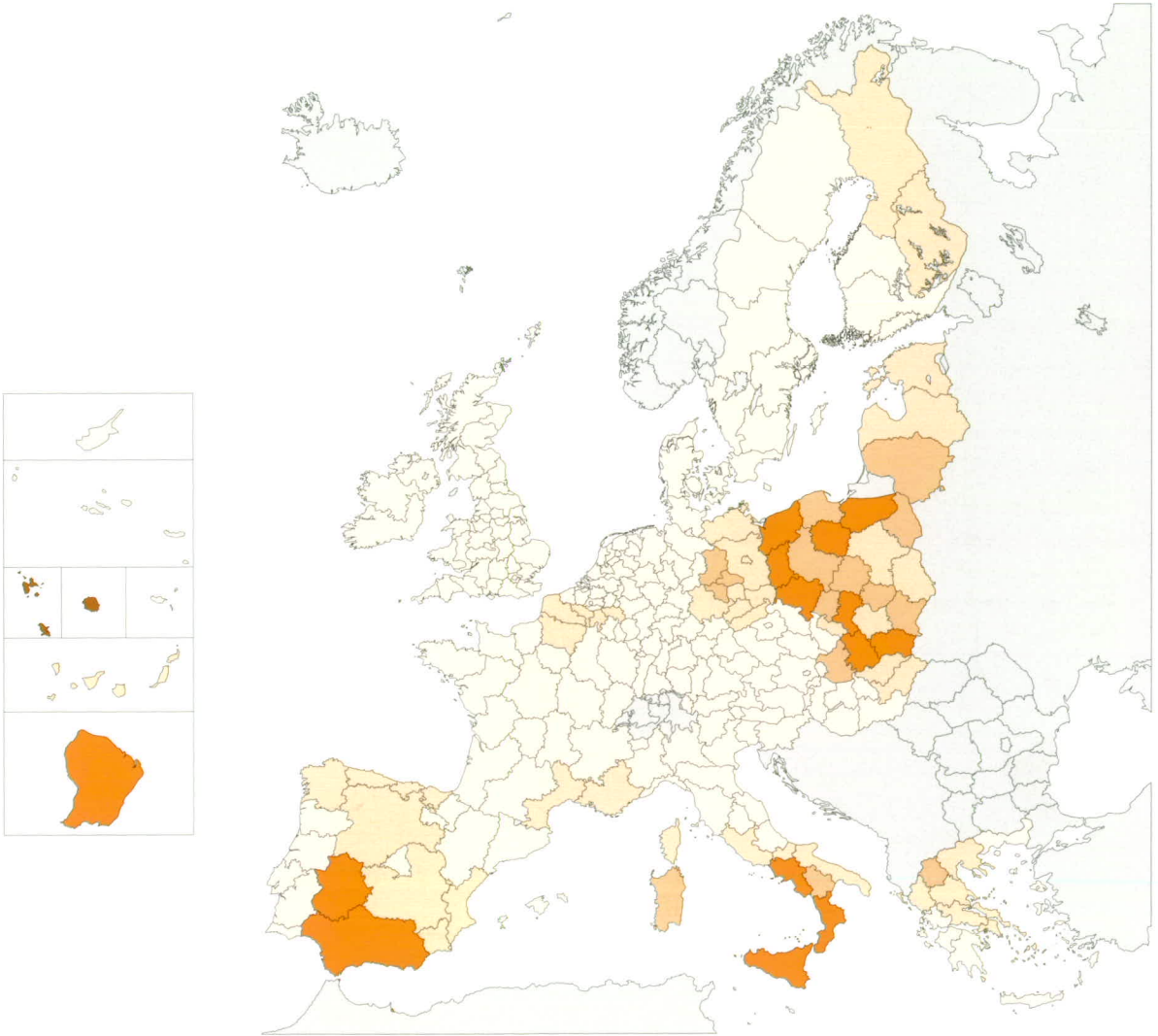

- 10/11/2004 **El volumen de agua embalsada se ha reducido un 4,5% durante el mes de octubre.**

- 08/11/2004 **En septiembre la producción industrial crece un 4,7%.**
En España el crecimiento fue del 3,9%
- 10/11/2004 **Madrid es el municipio más importante de España tanto en actividad económica como en cuota de mercado, producción industrial, comercio y turismo.**
El Anuario Económico de España 2004 de la Caixa señala la mejora de la Comunidad de Madrid en los principales indicadores.
