







## Population pyramid (thousands) as of 1 January, 2014




## Foreign population by nationality. 2014

## Evolution of births, deaths and marriages














## Registered health professionals per 1,000 population. 2013






## Distribution of adult and youth population according to their consumption of tobacco. 2013




## Distribution of youth and adult population according to their consumption of alcohol. 2013
















## Foreign trade by product groups. 2012




## Relative variation of population registered as resident. 2013-2014

Percentage




# Population Density. 2014

## Inhabitants/Km<sup>2</sup>




## Indicator of gross disposable municipal income per capita. 2012 (a)


